Following are some brief descriptions of the committees. EVERY job is important!

Food Preparation, Saturday, September 21, in the gym

This group will be helping to prepare food for BOB. Slicing and dicing to your hearts content!

Set Up/Decorating, Thursday, September 26, from noon to 5pm

Lots of help is needed to help set up tables, chairs, put up signs, decorate, etc. You will be busy!

Security – overnight Friday, September 27, and overnight Saturday, September 28, 10pm-8am (can be done in shifts) - This is an important job to keep the booths secure overnight.

Break Down, Sunday, September 29, 4pm to 6pm

Lots of help is needed to take down decorations, tables, chairs, etc.

Bakery Booth - Sells fresh baked goodies throughout the weekend. Yum!

Beer and Wine Garden (must be 21 or older) - Help set up, sell tickets for beer and wine, and monitor the secured area for adults only. This is a good spot to enjoy the music! On Sunday help is needed to take down tables and clean up.

Car Show (3 volunteers needed, Saturday only)

On Saturday only we host a classic car show. 3 volunteers are needed to help move the barriers to let the drivers in and to help guide them in parking their cars. Later in the morning the volunteers will see what the owners need and do food runs if requested.

Espresso/Italian Soda - Volunteers will make coffee drinks and Italian sodas. Maybe some Junior High and High School youth would like to help?

Filipino Food Booth

Volunteers will help set up and serve the delicious Filipino food. This is always a busy booth!

Green Team: Recycling and Garbage Pick Up

Volunteers are needed to make sure the trash, compost and recycling bins are emptied on a regular basis. Volunteers need to sort and take full bins to the large containers behind the gym. Last year the compost/recycling bins significantly reduced the amount of garbage BOB generated. Save the planet!

Hispanic Food Booth

Volunteers will help set up and serve the yummy Hispanic food. This booth can be quite busy!

Information Booth - Help folks with questions, directions, and other information about the Bite of Broadview.
