We reserve the right to determine the suitability of items offered for sale. No deviation from the menu will be allowed once you are accepted.

- Vendor agrees to be set up prior to the start of the Bite of Broadview Festival and remain on-site throughout the specified portions of this event. The Vendor booths must be adequately staffed at all times.
- The Festival's hours are Friday from 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. and Sunday, from 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Vendor set-up begins at noon on Friday. Vendors must remain open Friday until 8:00 p.m., Saturday until 8:00 p.m. and Sunday until 4:30 p.m.
- Vendors must display their Seattle Business License throughout the Festival and are responsible for all taxes and fees payable to the State under such license. Vendors must also have their Washington State UBI number/registration for payment of said taxes. Vendor warrants and represents that it is fully compliant with all municipal requirements applicable to its status as a Vendor including applicable food handler and health permits.
- One 120V outlet will be provided for food booths. Any Vendor requiring additional access to electricity or other facilities during the Festival must obtain advance permission of the Festival. The Festival reserves the right to refuse such access or to charge the Vendor an additional fee for such use. This policy is strictly enforced.
- Vendors must pay an all-inclusive fee of \$300.00 per 10x10 booth –no commission is taken- plus \$30 for a Seattle Business License (if you do not have one) for participation in the Festival. The fee must accompany this completed application and if accepted, is non-refundable. There will be a \$25 fee for any returned checks.
- Vendors agree to hold harmless the Bite of Broadview Festival, Christ the King School and Parish, its agents, employees, and assigns and all Festival organizers, chairpersons, and volunteers of the Festival, against any breakage or damage to goods, economic loss, the weather, acts of God, illness, accident, fire, theft, or any other claim, real or imagined, connected in any way with Vendor's participation in the Festival. Vendor further agrees to accept total liability for, defend and hold Christ the King School and Christ the King Parish harmless from any litigation resulting from any action of vendor, vendor's assigns or employees, while participating in the Festival. This Agreement is governed by Washington law. In the event of any claim or cause of action related to or in connection with this agreement or Vendor's registration or participation in the Festival, the prevailing party in any such action shall be entitled to reimbursement of its reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses.
- Vendor is responsible for all security relative to Vendor's goods and merchandise during the Festival, from the time of set-up until Vendor vacates the premises at the conclusion of the event. Vendor is also responsible for maintaining a clean area during the event.
- Vendors are required by the Fire Department to have a fire extinguisher in their booth.
